Author returns with new book on nation's debt

James McTevia, whose Bingham Farms firm **McTevia & Associates** was a pioneer in turnaround consulting, has written a new book,

The Culture of Debt: How a Once-Proud Society Mortgaged Its Future.

As Yogi Berra might say, it's déjà vu all over again.

In 1992, McTevia wrote

Bankrupt: A Society Living in the Future, which sounded the alarm about debt and America's addiction to

more and more of it.

The new book, which paints a picture of a looming, as opposed to recently averted, crisis, should be available by Sept. 7 on **Amazon.com** and other online retailers. The crisis, which McTevia calls a debt bomb, isn't inevitable, yet, but he says averting it is going to require an end to big government and entitlements.
